Our Learning

Literacy:
In Literacy we will be reading 'Escape from Pompeii' which is a story with a historical setting. We will then use this as the theme for our own writing. We will also be reading other books linked to our Roman topic to inspire us.

Numeracy:
In Numeracy we will be studying place value including negative numbers; addition and subtraction using the inverse to solve problems, 2D shape and measures, in particular time. We will also be recapping our multiplication tables.

Computing:
