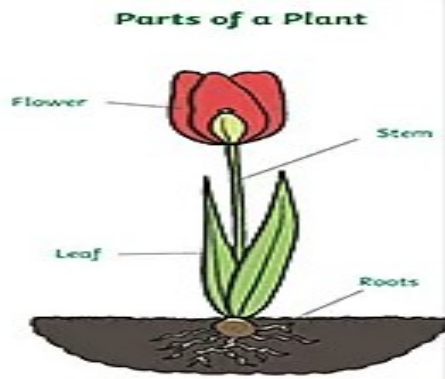
What grows in the garden?

We will be thinking about how to care for other living things such as plant and insects. We will also be thinking about how we can keep safe when outside.

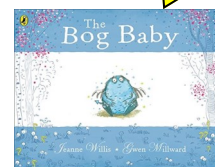


Literacy
