

Maths 123

In maths we are going to recap place value within 10 and look at number sequences, counting forwards and backwards, finding one more and one less and begin to compare these numbers using a range of mathematical symbols. We will then explore addition and subtraction using a variety of equipment.

Art/DT



In Art and DT we will explore a range of skills to create self-portraits. We will be using paint to colour mix to create skin tones and also look at how to use sketching pencils correctly to sketch portraits of our friends. We will also be focusing on Picasso and recreating his famous work.

ICT



In ICT we will spend time, understanding the rules and how we can use the computers safely to complete activities. We will also be learning the parts of a computer and understand what they are for. Later on in the term, we will be using the bee-bots to sequence.

Geography



As part of our Geography lessons we will go on a walk to explore our local area. We will look at the different features of our environment and make our own maps, using labels and correct map symbols to show the different things we saw on the walk. We will also be using maps of the United Kingdom to identify where we live in the wider world.

Science



Our focus for Science is 'observing'. We will learn more about our bodies and the importance of different body parts, thinking about what we must do to keep our bodies healthy. Each week we will explore each of our five senses and carry out investigations to understand more about them.

RE



In RE we will look at different religions and how key events are celebrated.

Literacy

In Literacy we will be looking at a variety of different writing genres and focusing on our handwriting and spelling. Throughout the half term we will focus on our sentence structure ensuring we understand capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
