IN JUNE 2026, ALL YEAR 10 STUDENTS WILL TAKE PART IN A ONE-WEEK WORK PLACEMENT, OFFERING A VALUABLE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPERIENCE THE WORLD OF WORK AND DEVELOP ESSENTIAL SKILLS SUCH AS COMMUNICATION, TEAMWORK, AND PROBLEM-SOLVING

TO SUPPORT STUDENTS IN PREPARING FOR THIS, THEY HAVE TAKEN PART IN THRIVE LESSONS AND WE RUN AFTER-SCHOOL SESSIONS EVERY THURSDAY FROM 3:15-4:00 PM IN IT4, WHERE PUPILS CAN RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES AND LEARN HOW TO APPROACH BUSINESSES FOR INSIGHT INTO THEIR WORKPLACE.
