Jesus's Disciples






The brothers were called James and John. Jesus spoke to them. They also immediately left their nets, the boat and their father and followed Jesus.



On the way to Galilee, Jesus found Phillip and his friend Bartholomew. They started following Jesus and became his next disciples.








James was the youngest disciple and was sometimes called James the Younger.
