

# Year 3 – Spring 2 2025

## English

In English, children will be in groups. Mr Booth's class will be continuing embedding their phonics, letter formation and reading skills. Mrs Maud, Miss Lees and Mrs Griffith's classes will be reading Ancient Greek myths, including Daedalus and Icarus and Theseus and the Minotaur. We will use these myths as inspiration for our writing, concentrating on writing in paragraphs, using speech marks and using subordinate clauses.

## Maths

In Maths, we will continue to practise and become confident with our 3, 4 and 8 times tables, looking closely at multiplication and division methods.

## Computing

In Computing we will be completing our coding unit and moving on to learning about spread sheets.

## Science

In Science we will be learning all about Light. We will look at different light sources and shadows. We will also learn about how light reflects and travels.

## CLICK

In CLICK we will be learning all about Ancient Greece. We will order important historical events from the period on a timeline as well as learn all about the Olympic games. Children will also have the opportunity to learn about myths and stories from Ancient Greece.

## RE

We will continue to learn how Jews remember God's covenant and build on children's experiences of reading and learning religious stories.

	BC	<b>BC</b> comes from Before Christ. <b>BC</b> means before Jesus was born.
	AD	<b>AD</b> comes from the Latin Anno Domini meaning 'In the year of our Lord.' <b>AD</b> means after Jesus was born.
	Ancient	Something belonging to the very distant past and no longer in existence
	Europe	A continent in the Northern hemisphere made up of 44 countries.
	Civilisation	In this context, the word ' <b>civilisation</b> ' is used to describe a human society with well-developed rules and government, often where technology and the arts are considered important.
	City status	Small areas that ancient Greece was divided into, each with their own governments, laws and army.
	Empire	A group of countries or states that is ruled by one ruler or country.
	Legacies	Things that live on after someone dies or after a civilisation or event ends.
Olympics	A set of international sports competitions that happen once every four years.
