

English

This term we will begin with reading the picture book 'Flotsam'. Using this text, we will develop our oracy skills, discussing the book. We will also look at this text to further develop skills both in reading and writing.

Maths

We will continue to learn about fractions. Children will look at different representations that make a whole and utilise their knowledge of equal parts to name and record the written fraction. Children will explore mass and capacity beginning to read scales and intervals accurately. We will also learn how to tell the time on both analogue and digital clocks.

Computing

In Computing we will be making a presentation. This will include adding media, changing the design of the slides and adding animations.

Science

We will be learning all about plants. We will learn the names and function of the parts of a flower and dissect some flowers. We will also learn about pollination, seed dispersal and the life cycle of plants. We will also grow our own plants from seeds.

CLICK

We will be learning all about Europe. We will learn about some of the famous landmarks in Europe, labelling them on a map and use an atlas. We will also learn about the different foods eaten across Europe, before tasting some ourselves.

RE

We will be learning about, 'what is the best way for a Jew to live a good life?' We will learn about Abraham, the founder of Judaism, and how Jewish believers try to lead a good life through doing good in the world.
